## Overview of the ATV Law and the Pennsylvania Vehicle Code

The ATV Law is contained in [Chapter 77 of the Pennsylvania Vehicle Code](#). The following are a few of the items in the ATV Law and Regulations that you need to be aware of and obey.

1. Pennsylvania residents owning and intending to use their ATV in PA (except those used exclusively as a farm or business vehicle) must be titled and registered with DCNR's ATV Registration Section.
2. A PA General Registration permits the machine to be operated off the owner or operator's private property. A registration plate and expiration sticker must be properly displayed on the back of the ATV and a registration certificate card must be carried by the operator.
3. A Limited Registration is for machines used exclusively on the property of the owner. There is no fee and the registration does not expire. The owner is provided with a registration plate and a card, but no expiration sticker.
4. ATVs owned by nonresidents and covered by a valid registration in their state, province, or country that honors a Pennsylvania registration are exempt from registration requirements.
5. Liability insurance coverage is required for all ATVs operated off of the property of the owner. Proof of this coverage should be carried by the operator.
6. Persons under the age of 8 years of age may not operate an ATV on public lands.
7. Persons past their 8th birthday but under 16 years of age must complete an ATV safety education course and possess a safety certificate before being permitted to operate an ATV on any public land trails.
8. Age 8 or 9 year old operators are restricted to an engine size of 70 cc or less.



## Guidelines and Best Practices for Riding on State Forest Lands

1. Become familiar with and abide by [State Forest Rules and Regulations](#) and the [ATV law](#).
2. Stay on trails and other open areas designated for ATVs. Be an advocate for your sport and don't enter areas which are posted closed.
3. Designated ATV trails on state forest lands will be open from the Friday before Memorial Day through the last full weekend in September. Some ATV trails reopen after deer season and remain open until April 1, conditions permitting.
4. Respect the rights of others who use state forest lands.
5. Do not disturb or pursue wildlife with your ATV.
6. Be familiar with your machine and operate it in a safe and responsible manner.
7. Always wear safety gear including a helmet, eye protection, and protective clothing when riding.
8. Use the buddy system and let others know where you are riding.
9. Be aware of local weather forecasts. Dress and equip yourself appropriately.
10. Be prepared for the unexpected. Carry a map, tool kit, first-aid kit, and other emergency items.
11. Do not carry passengers on your ATV unless the machine is designed for that purpose.
12. Do not carry loaded firearms on your ATV.
13. Maintain your equipment. Inspect the ATV and make sure it is functioning correctly before you ride.
14. Never operate an ATV under the influence of drugs or alcohol.
15. Know your personal limits and abilities.
16. The Bureau of Forestry's local District Forester is responsible for the trail and may close part or all of the facility as necessary.
17. Discard all litter in waste containers provided or take it out with you.

## The ATVenturer's Pledge

- I will learn all the mechanical controls and safety devices of my ATV by reading the owner's manual and I will check them each time before I ride.
- I will always wear a helmet and other protective clothing suitable to the environment when I ride.
- I will only ride my ATV on trails designated and posted open to ATVs.
- I will not carry passengers on my ATV unless the machine is designed for that purpose.
- I will not let young riders go ATVenturing unsupervised.
- I will not use alcohol or other drugs when I ride.
- I will only lend my ATV to someone I have personally instructed in its safe and appropriate use.
- I will ask an instructor or qualified rider to teach me proper riding skills and I will practice until my skills are well developed before entering an unfamiliar area.
- I will ride in the company of others, never alone.
- I will respect the laws when I ride and I will honor the rules when I ride.
- I will not modify the ATV exhaust system to create more noise.
- I will not litter or cause damage to natural resources where I ride.
- I will be courteous to other riders and persons by offering right-of-way and respect areas that are posted.
