

Pool Info & Admission Rates

Pool Dimensions: Did you know the pool is in the shape of a whale? Depth ranges from 0 entry to 5 feet. It contains 550,000 gallons of water. There are two 8 ft. water slides and several spray features in the zero-depth entry area of the pool.

Admission at the ticket booth is **CASH ONLY**

Credit card transactions may be made at the park office or Marina Visitor Center during normal business hours.

Valid Pennsylvania ID must be shown to receive PA Resident admission rate.

If no ID is provided, Non-Resident fee will be charged.

2015 Swimming Pool Policies & Information

Pool Rules

A complete listing of park rules and regulations can be obtained at the park office or throughout billboards in the park.

- Coolers, beverages, and food are **prohibited** in this facility unless they are purchased and consumed at the concession stand
- Pets are not permitted in the pool area for sanitary reasons
- Pool patrons must wear bathing suits in the pool. No street clothes or cutoffs allowed. No exceptions are made.
- Parents and counselors are required to adequately monitor their family or group. Children 9 years of age and younger must be supervised by a responsible person 14 years of age or older. No person shall supervise more than 5 children. Any group that does not comply may be asked to leave and no refund will be given
- Prolonged breath holding is prohibited—it can cause unexpected death!
- No running is permitted inside the pool area. Children may be put in “time out” if they have to be told repeatedly not to run
- Diving is prohibited in any area of the pool. This is considered to be any headfirst entry into the water
- No horseplay, dunking, sitting on people’s shoulders, or hanging on the ropes will be permitted
- Smoking and food permitted only in the designated area.
- No profanity or obscene/offensive language will be tolerated
- No LOUD music

Lifeguards MUST be obeyed at all times!

These rules and regulations are designed to ensure the safety of all patrons of this facility.

Admission Policies

Hand Stamping

Nockamixon State Park Swimming Pool frequently receives more than 1,000 visitors a day. In order to make it possible for people to leave and re-enter the pool area easily, we use a hand stamp system.

The stamp is available at the exit window as you leave. Make sure you **ASK** for a stamp if you wish to re-enter the pool area. The stamp is NOT waterproof, and it is NOT permanent. You are responsible for maintaining your stamp. If the stamp begins to wear off or fade, please get re-stamped.

We may refuse admission if:

- You do not have a visible hand stamp.
- You have transferred your hand stamp onto someone else, or you have received a transferred hand stamp.
- You have been asked to leave by the lifeguards or park staff.
- You are under the age of 10, and do not have a responsible adult with you. The gate staff does try to stop all unaccompanied children, however we are not always successful. Please accompany your children through the gate to prevent them from becoming stuck inside or outside the pool gate.
- You are bringing in food or drink other than water or baby formula.
- You have a pet. Pets are not permitted in the pool area for sanitary reasons.
- The pool reaches capacity. Once capacity is reached, only people with valid hand stamps will be admitted. Pool staff may begin admitting new visitors as others leave.

Inclement Weather

Generally, the pool remains open during all inclement weather EXCEPT thunderstorms. At the first sign of a thunderstorm (lightning or thunder), the lifeguards will immediately clear the pool and the pool area of users.

The pool will reopen 30 minutes after ALL visible and audible signs of the storm have passed.

Visitors should seek shelter during inclement weather and will need a hand stamp to re-enter the pool area.

Only guests with hand stamps may come into the pool area during this closure. No new admission will be sold until the pool is reopened.

IF THE POOL CLOSSES FOR ANY REASON, REFUNDS WILL NOT BE ISSUED!

Additional Information

Access for People with Disabilities

There is a ramp at the ticket booth area leading down to the main pool complex area. The shallow end of the pool is zero-entry and a wheelchair lift is also available. If you need an accommodation to participate in park activities due to a disability, please contact the park office.

Floaties and Other Swimming Gear

THE FOLLOWING ARE PERMITTED:

- Most floating equipment is permitted in the swimming pool, including noodles, water wings, and children’s floatation vests.
- Inner tubes
- Goggles and face masks
- Swimming diapers are REQUIRED for infants and toddlers who normally wear diapers. Swim diapers are available for sale at the concession stand.

THE FOLLOWING ARE NOT PERMITTED:

- Regular diapers.
- Snorkels, swim fins, or SCUBA equipment.
- Street clothing.

Food

Outside food and beverages are prohibited. Bottled water and baby formula are permitted. Food may be purchased at the concession stand, near the pool area. Concession food must be consumed at the concession stand patio area and is not permitted anywhere else within the pool complex. Lifeguards, park rangers, or ticket booth staff may confiscate any food found outside the concession area. **Coolers are NOT permitted in the swimming pool area.**

First Aid, Lost & Found

Available at the Lifeguard station.

Waterslides

You must be able to either stand with your head out of the water at the water slides, or be able to swim across the width of the pool before using the slides. Be prepared to take the swim test if required by the lifeguard!
