

Special Notice:
Any Snowmobile Road (Joint Use) May Be Closed At Any Time To Snowmobiles By The District Forester When There Are Conflicting Uses. Such Roads Will Be Posted As "Closed To Snowmobiles."

Roads:
Any Road To Be Legally Open For Snowmobiling Must Be Posted With The Appropriate Signs.
