





Central PA Fly Fishing Tour

Central Pennsylvania is home to many natural and recreational resources. To many, the Central PA area is considered the mecca of trout fishing on the East Coast. With world renowned streams such as Spring Creek, Penns Creek, Fishing Creek, and the Little Juniata, the opportunities for trout anglers are almost endless. The staff of Bald Eagle State Park and the Nature Inn welcome you to participate in an all encompassing fly fishing weekend.

The Fly Fishing Tour will kick off at 4:00pm on Friday evening with a casting demonstration and practice by fly fishing guide and instructor, Dave McMullen. After a locally sourced and prepared dinner by the Nature Inn, an evening fly tying session will offer participants the opportunity to learn the basics in the art of tying.

After an early breakfast on Saturday, guests will drive to Spring Creek at Fisherman's Paradise outside of Bellefonte for a day of stream biology and wild trout fishing with the Park Naturalist. A stream side lunch will be provided by the Nature Inn. Dave McMullen will join the guests again on Saturday evening for a Nymphing Strategy discussion.

Be sure to pack your bags early on Sunday as you will travel to Fishing Creek after breakfast for some additional stream time before departing for the day.
